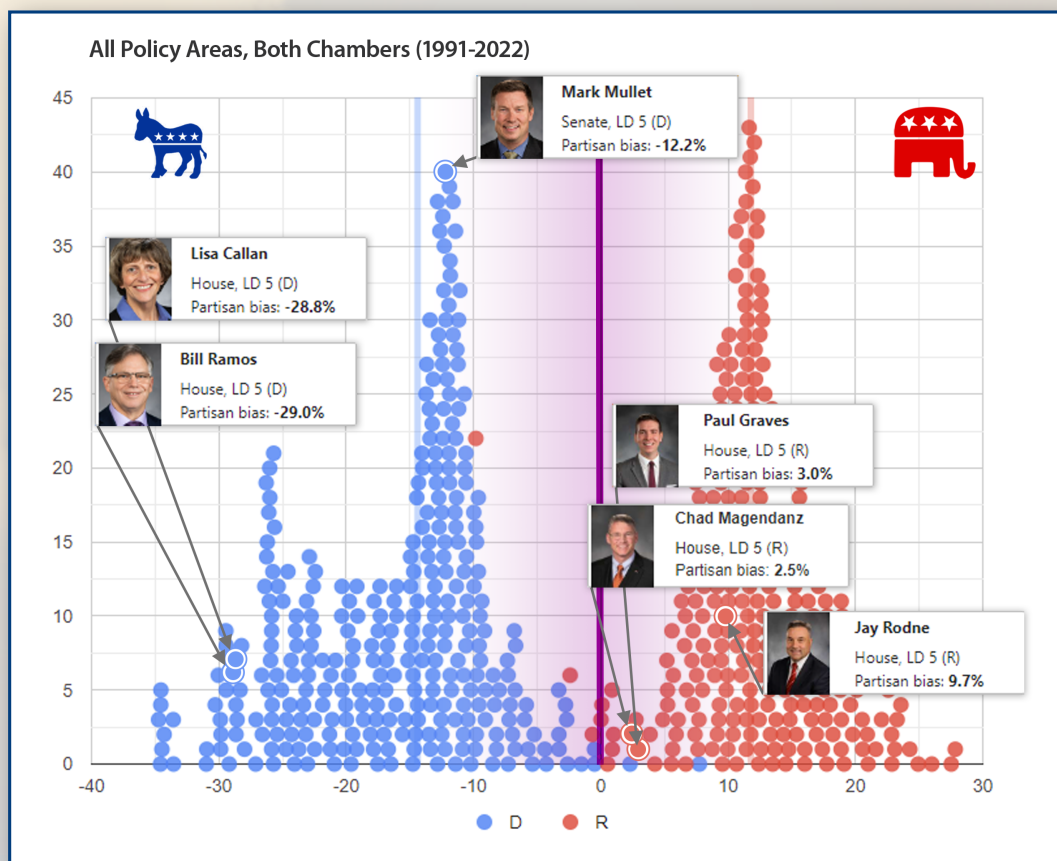

Doubled School Funding

As a lead negotiator on the McCleary school funding case and co-chair of the joint oversight committee, Chad increased funding for public schools by **105% over 8 years**.

Cut College Tuition
