Fast facts:

- The current forecast predicts \$2B in new revenue for this budget, a 6.6% increase!
- We must show steady progress towards funding basic education reforms by 2018
- Medicaid expansion should save our state \$266M (while feds match 100%)
- Estate tax fix (Bracken) should save \$160M
- Continuing the I-732 (Teacher COLAs) suspension saves our state \$320M
- Median household income has dropped
 2.4% since I-732 was suspended in 2009
- 23 counties still have unemployment rates over 9.1%
- Sequestration is already slowing our recovery and adds \$3.5B in payroll taxes
