Note: The intent of Initiative 120 was to protect a woman's right to choose to have an abortion <u>prior to viability of the fetus</u>, or to <u>protect her life or health</u>. While I would oppose legislation aiming to ban specific methods, I would at least consider legislation to ban late-term abortions when the mother's life or health was not endangered. That said, I did oppose I-694 because it was poorly written and worded in such a vague way that it could be construed to ban abortions other than the controversial, late-term procedure.
